(3) We authorize verification of the registrant's date of birth from legal records to be provided to a Cal South authorized representative for the limited purpose of verifying the Cal South player's age and identity. (4) We consent to emergency medical care prescribed by a duly licensed Health Care Provider or Dentist. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb or registrant's well-being and we hereby agree to be financially responsible for all costs associated with such treatment. (5) We consent to Cal South taking photographs, video recordings, and/or sound recordings in documenting the activities of Cal South's programs and services. We hereby grant Cal South and their affiliates' permission to use the negatives, prints, motion pictures, video/audio tapings, or any other reproduction of the same for Cal South and its affiliates' educational and promotional purposes in manuals, on flyers, the internet, or other publications. ## Agreement to CVMSC Policies



### Refund policy

It is the policy of CVMSC to issue refunds in the event your child sustains a season ending injury/illness, or if your family moves out of the San Diego Area. Any refunds to be paid out will be based on the following guidelines:

All team seasons start May 1<sup>st</sup> and continue through December (8 month duration). Older teams, those with high school aged players may end at the end of November, due to CIF rules and regulations.

Regardless of your son or daughter's participation during this period (i.e. missing practices due to other commitments, etc.); you are charged from May 1st until the written submission to your coach of your desire to be released from the team. A \$395 administrative fee is deducted initially from your registration fee for CYSA and other league costs including the club fundraising raffle. After deducting the non-refundable \$495 administrative fee, the remaining amount is divided over the 8 months of the contract. No fee will be prorated for a partial month. Once the month starts, you are charged the full month.

**Example:** Assume you submit the written request to be released from the team on July 12th, your refund would be as follows:

League fee	\$1,895

Divided by 8 month season

Less 3 months charge	<u>\$ (525)</u>

**Please note:** In no case, will any refund be allowed after September 30th.

**Commitment:** Besides attending all practices and games ready to play, there may be additional responsibilities and sacrifices a family has to make to support the team and the club. CVMSC families are encouraged to get involved and support club activities such as the Manchester Cup, our summer tournament held in June; our fundraising raffle; and the CVMSC Gala, with its live and silent auctions.

CVMSC will schedule 2 weeks of soccer camps to benefit both team and individual development. It is extremely important that players attend their team camps, the value of 40 hours of coaching is significant in the development of young players, please let your coach know if you cannot attend the camps. **The cost of the first week of soccer camp is included in the registration fee;** the second week of camp is offered at \$95. Additionally, any player who attends two weeks of camp is welcome to attend a free week of camp at summer's end.

**Conflict Resolution:** Each player and parent as well as coaches and club officials, must sign the Club's Code of Conduct at registration. These rules are set in order to ensure the highest standards of sportsmanship, and moral and ethical conduct. As members of the Club, we are expected to understand, follow and uphold these rules. The league strives to offer the best possible soccer experience for our children. It is in everyone's best interest to resolve conflicts at an early stage. As with any activity involving a large group of people, conflicts will arise during the course of a season. Individual issues should be brought to the attention of the coach first for discussion and resolution. If a resolution cannot be reached, the issue should be elevated to Billy Garton, Head Coach and/or Jeff Illingworth, Director of Coaching. Please remember that our team managers and the CVMSC Board are volunteers, and have given of their own time and effort to make your son and daughter's soccer experience a good one. Please treat them as you would want them to treat you if you were in their position. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Parents and/or players must also sign the Agreement to Policies at registration as well.

**Refund Policy:** Refunds will only be given in exceptional circumstances, leaving the club in good faith and for reasons beyond the control of player and parents (moving out of area, serious injury, etc.). Any refund that is given (after deducting a non-refundable administrative fee) is determined by Billy Garton and Jeff Illingworth.

**Carmel Valley Manchester Soccer Club is committed to providing the best soccer experience for not only the players but for their families as well. Coaches will stress the values of teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline and hard work, enabling players to reach their full potential.**

# Carmel Valley Manchester Soccer Club

Carmel Valley Manchester Soccer Club is a 501(c)3 Non-Profit, community-based organization run by volunteers to support youth soccer. CVMSC is a competitive Soccer Club that hopes to assist players from the Carmel Valley area and the surrounding communities who want to train and play in a more competitive soccer environment than is available in the local recreational programs, and who are willing to make a commitment to the program. The program is designed for players who are interested in playing at a competitive level, maximizing their development of individual soccer skills, techniques, tactics and team play. Equal value is placed on winning and player development. CVMSC will hire the best available professional coaches to teach and develop players and teams in order to reach their maximum playing potential. Not only will players develop their soccer abilities, they will be learning the value of discipline, hard work, and leadership by example, teamwork, sportsmanship, and fair play- important traits that will make them successful in future endeavors.

Founded in 2001 by Jeff Illingworth and Billy Garton, the Club has grown steadily over time and has established itself as one of the more accomplished soccer programs in Southern California. Carmel Valley Manchester Soccer Club recruits professionally licensed coaches who have played and/or coached at a highly competitive level. Coaches are hired based on the confidence that they will be able to accomplish the goals and objectives described above, and are assigned teams based on coaching style and age groups of the players.

**Teams:** Players are invited to join a team based on the results of the pre-season tryout sessions. Sessions consist of drills and scrimmages that allow players to demonstrate their abilities. Coaches will select players who demonstrate solid skills, as well as a positive attitude.

Once tryouts are complete and the teams are formed, each team will have a meeting between the coach and parents to discuss specific objectives for the upcoming season and set a training schedule. Coaches will discuss their expectations of players and parents, and any special team rules. Coaches will also discuss what tournaments they would like to participate in during the year. A parent is named Manager; he/she assists the coach on administrative matters and attends regular meetings to keep apprised of Club activities. Having a very reliable Manager with good communication skills is critical to smooth operation of the team. Another parent could also be named the Assistant Manager.

**Training:** Training will consist of two 1 & 1/2 hour practices per week. Training will begin May 1st and continue through December 31st. Coaches and players will get the following holidays off of training: Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Years Eve and New Years Day.

**Tournaments:** Teams are strongly encouraged to participate in pre-season tournaments to prepare for the League games. Every CVMSC team is expected to participate in the Manchester Cup in June and supply tournament volunteers. Teams that have winning records during the Presidio Season are strongly encouraged to participate in post-season tournaments (including, but not limited to, State & National Cup). If the majority of the team chooses to participate in the post-season training and tournaments, the cost of continuous training and tournaments will be shared equally by all parents of the team, and are in addition to CVMSC fees.

**Fees:** At Manchester we consciously seek to hire the best coaches, we expect a high level of commitment and have created full time coaching positions for our coaches.

The CVMSC 2012 registration fee for all ages is \$1945 per player. If payment is received by cash or check a \$50 discount is given. Included in the registration fee is \$100 towards raffle fundraising tickets that you will receive at the time of registration. These tickets can then be sold to individuals of your choice as a personal fundraiser. A complete list of items included in your registration is listed herein. The club offers a family discount of \$100 for each sibling of a full paying player.

**CVMSC offers three payment options:**

**Please note a separate payment for raffle tickets will be collected at time of registration.**

- **Payments received by cash or check \$1895 (\$50 discount may be taken)**
- **Payments made in full at time of registration receive a bonus of \$50 in raffle tickets**
- **Two-payment plan, at no extra charge. \$950 at time of registration and a post-dated check in the amount of \$945 dated (7/1/11) .**
- **Up to six monthly payments. (1) \$725 and (6) \$200 posted dated checks are due at registration. A \$5 admin fee per payment applies.**

Payments can be made using Visa, Master Card and Discover credit cards, but their will be no discount in the registration fees. Bonus raffle tickets are still earned based on payment option used above.

\*\* Late payments could result in the withdrawal of your child's player card and may prevent them from playing for their team until the outstanding amount is paid in full.

Checks are to be made payable to CVMSC. Please note player's name and team on the check. Please refer to our *Agreement to Policies* for our late sign-up fee schedule and our Refund Policy.

Registration Fees will include:

- Professional Coaching Fees (May through December)
- **One week of summer soccer camp**
- Goalie clinics
- Team photograph (basic package)
- Club registration
- League fees
- CYSA registration
- Field, lights and referee fees
- Game equipment and use of fields
- Administrative costs
- Player Insurance
- Uniform kit (includes two practice tees, two pair of shorts, two pair socks and one hooded sweatshirt)

It is important that all fees are paid on schedule, as players may not be allowed to participate if fees are past due.

Additional costs incurred as part of playing competitive soccer include, but are not limited to, the following:

- There may be additional coaching fees in post season for the high profile teams going on to state cup and post season tournaments.
- Tournament fees: The actual fees based on each team's participation, prorated by the player. For example: Eagles Summer Classic fees are \$550, divided by 14 players on the team is a charge of \$40 per player. The Coach's tournament travel is also covered by the team.
- Optional Extra Training Gear: Some parents would like additional shorts, tees and socks for their players for training. We offer an additional training package of one tee, short and socks for \$40.00. You may purchase this at any time.
- Optional Backpacks, Warm up Jackets and Pants: These items are available for purchase through the Club supplier. All items include the team logo.

**Scholarships:** Every year CVMSC provides scholarships for players whom otherwise would not be able to participate. Range in amount depending on financial qualifications. **Families of players who receive scholarships are expected to pay for the uniform kits and contribute to the club a minimum of 20 volunteer hours.** To apply for a scholarship, please contact Billy Garton and /or Jeff Illingworth. Scholarship funds are limited. We are now able to accept Visa and MasterCard for donations and scholarships. As we are a non-profit organization, there are tax advantages that may be realized.
